MAJOR PROJECTS OF THE SUNDANCE ASSOCIATION



Sundance Saloon, our primary project, offers twice-weekly country-western dance instruction and open dancing. The past few years has seen tremendous growth at Sundance Saloon, with hundreds attending weekly. Sundance Saloon wholly succeeds in accomplishing our mission of dance education, the primary basis for our 501c3 nonprofit designation, offering multiple lessons in a variety of dance styles each week.

The Sundance Association sponsors **public outdoor festival community dances** at the San Francisco Pride Festival, Castro Street Fair, and Hairrison Street Fair. These events are paramount in introducing country-western dancing to the general LGBT public. The Sundance Association also supports the broader community through special fundraising events, and has raised more than \$150,000 over the past 10 years.





The Sundance Stompede, our annual country-western dance weekend, offers four intensive days of dance workshops and dance events. Each year hundreds attend from throughout the continent. In 2007 the event raised over \$20,000 for the AIDS/Breast Cancer Emergency Fund and Rainbow World Fund. In 2008 the Stompede will again host the convention of the International Association of Gay/Lesbian Dance Clubs.

Sundance Country-Western Dance Cruises, in collaboration with RSVP Vacations, are an important part of our mission. Whether presenting one or two sessions of lessons with night-time dances, to more elaborate weeks with several dance workshops and multiple nights of dancing, the Sundance presence on these cruises has fostered even more interest in CW dancing.
