A nominal \$5 fee will be charged. Solomon is well-known as a teacher and competitor, with many TV, film and stage credits.



Also on **Sunday, April 25**, **Lee Fox** (Ft. Lauderdale) will teach **intermediate waltz** in the Main Room 5:30-6:30 pm. This is a **drop-in class** with no preregistration and no additional fee. Lee



has been teaching country-western dance for 19 years. He is competition director for the International Association of Gay/Lesbian Country-Western Dance Clubs, and he's a favorite returning instructor at the Sundance Stompede.

And on **Thursday, May 6**, Johnny Quarto-vonTivadar (New York) will lead a free **drop-in intermediate west coast swing** workshop in the Main Room 7:00-8:00 pm. This workshop will present some differences between "country" and "mainstream" west coast swing styles. Johnny is on the board of the Gotham Swing Club and directs the west coast swing dance events at the Sundance Stompede.

Music: Honky Tonk Attitude – Joe Diffie (Sundance edit)

Begin: Sweetheart's position, side by side, leader to the left of the follower and behind, right hands joined on follower's right shoulder, left hands joined in front.

count	step
1-3	Both: Step L to the left, cross R behind L, step L to the left
4	Both: Scuff R
5-7	Both: Step R to the right, cross L behind R, step R to the right
8	Both: Scuff L
9-11	(Follower crosses to the left in front of leader) Leader: Step in place L, R, L Follower: Step L to the left, cross R behind L, step L to the left
12	Both: Scuff R
13-15	(Both turn to face opposite line of dance) Both: Step in place R, L, R with ½-turn to the left
16	Both: Scuff L
17-19	(Follower crosses to the left in front of leader) Leader: Step in place L, R, L Follower: Step L to the left, cross R behind L, step L to the left
20	Both: Scuff R
21-23	(Both turn to face line of dance) Both: Step in place R, L, R with ½-turn to the left
24	Both: Scuff L
25-27	Both: Step forward L, R, L
28	Both: Scuff R
29-31	Both: Step back R, L, R
32	Both: Scuff L
33-35	(Leader lets go of right hand, turns follower with left hand) Leader: Step in place L, R, L Follower: Step to the left of leader L, R, L with ½-turn to the right
36	Both: Scuff R and grasp left hands (leader and follower facing)
37-39	(Extend right hand and pull each other by) Both: Grasping right hands with next partner, step forward R, L, R
40	Both: Scuff L
41-43	(Extend left hand and pull each other by) Both: Grasping left hands with next partner, step forward L, R, L
44	Both: Scuff R
45-47	(Leader picks up next follower's right hand and turns partner) Leader: Grasping right hand of next partner, step in place R, L, R Follower: Step in place R, L, R with ½-turn to the left
48	(Resume Sweetheart's position) Both: Scuff L
