DOYOUR THING

4-wall line dance

Music: "Do Your Thing" – Basement Jaxx

- 1-2 Step forward R [hands right], L [hands left]
- 3&4 Shuffle forward R [hands right], L [hands left], R [hands right]
- 5-6 Step forward L [hands left], R [hands right]
- 7&8 Shuffle forward L [hands left], R [hands right], L [hands left]
- 9, 10 Step R forward [arms up/right], step L forward [arms up/left]
- 11, 12 Step R back [arms down/right], step L back [arms down/left]
- 13, 14 Cross R over L, unwind ½ turn to the left (weight on the R)
- 15&16 Bounce L heel twice, step on L [push palms down/left each count]
- 17, 18 Step R to the right, cross L over R
- 19&20 Bounce R heel twice, step on R [push palms down/left each count]
- 21, 22 Step L to the left, cross R over L
- 23&24 Bounce L heel twice, step on L [push palms down/left each count]
- 25, 26 Cross R over L, step L back turning 1/4 right
- 27, 28 Step R to right, touch L next to R
- 29&30 Step L forward, lock step R up behind L, step L forward
- &31& Step R forward, lock step L up behind R, step R forward
- 32 Turn 1/4 left and step L forward
- 33-35 Bounce L heel 3 times (shift weight to R)
- 36 Kick L forward
- 37, 38 Rock L back, recover R
- 39&40 Shuffle forward L,R,L spinning a full turn right
- 41, 42 Turn 1/8 right and step forward R, L
- 43, 44 Step R forward, pivot ½-turn to the left and step L forward
- 45, 46 Step forward R, L
- 47, 48 Step R forward, pivot ³/₄-turn to the left and step L forward
- 49, 50 Step forward R, L
- 51, 52 Step R forward, pivot ½-turn to the left and step L forward
- 53, 54 Step forward R, L
- 55, 56 Bounce both heels three times with 3/8-turn to the left [right arm extends in arc overhead]
- 57, 58 Rock R forward, recover L
- 59&60 Shuffle forward R,L,R with ½-turn to the right
- 61, 62 Rock L forward, recover R
- 63&64 shuffle forward L,R,L with 3/4 turn to the left

BREAK — after 4 full rotations

- Pivot on L 1/4-turn to left and step on R [arms extended]
- 2-4 Hold
- 5 Pivot on R ½-turn to the right and step on L [arms extended]
- 6-8 Hold
- 9 Pivot on L ½-turn to the left and step on R [arms extended]
- 10-12 Hol
- Pivot on R ¹/₄-turn to the right and step on L [arms extended]
- 14-16 Hold
