### SUNDANCE SALOON TO OPEN FRIDAYS

Sundance Saloon enters a new era with the expansion to Friday nights beginning July 6. And not only will there be country-western dancing and lessons three times a week, but Sundance Saloon will broaden its scope to offer even more to the community.

Friday nights will offer three simultaneous rooms of dance instruction from 8 to 9pm: beginning two-step, line dance, and intermediate west coast swing. Then at 9pm you can choose between open country-western dancing in the Main Room, a Line Dance Hour in the Green Room, and Country Karaoke in the Red Room.

At 10pm in the Green Room, following the Line Dance Hour, there will be a weekly Retro Disco Party, featuring the great classics from the 70s and 80s. We hope the variety of options all under one roof will bring in more community into Sundance Saloon. And of course we expect that some who come primarily for the karaoke and disco

will catch the country-western dance fever as well.

Sundays and Thursdays will continue with the same format as before. We expect Sundays to remain popular as a great way to end the weekend. And Thursdays will still serve as an important opportunity to dance in a less intense and more intimate setting.

The Sundance Association once again presents country-western dancing at the San Francisco Pride celebration at the same great location as last year.


