9, 10 11, 12 13, 14 15&16	Rock L forward, recover on R Rock L back, recover on R Touch L heel forward, hitch L knee Step L back, step R together, step L forward
17 &18 19&20 21, 22 23&24	Hitch R knee Pivot ½-turn to the right while lowering and raising R knee Step R back, step L together, step R forward Touch L toe to left, press L heel down Kick L over R, step L next to R, step R next to L
