&4	Step R next to L, cross L over R
5, 6	Rock R to the right, recover L

7&8 Cross R over L, step L next to R, cross R over L

9, 10	Step L to the left, cross R behind L
&11	Step L to the left, cross R over L
&12	Step L next to R, cross R over L
13, 14	Rock L to the left, recover R

15&16 Cross L over R, step R next to L, cross L over R

17, 18 Step R to the right, hold and clap

19&20 Cross L behind R, step R to the right, cross L over R

21, 22 Step R to the right, hold and clap

23&24 Cross L behind R, step R to the right, step L forward

25, 26 Stomp R over L, hold

&27, 28 Step L next to R, stomp R over left, hold

29, 30 Step L to the left, turn ¼-turn to the right and step R back

31&32 Step L back, step R next to L, step L forward
