19, 20* Cross R behind L, touch L to the left
21, 22 Cross L over R, step R to the right

23, 24 Cross L behind R, 1/4-turn right and step R forward

25, 26 Step L forward, pivot ½-turn right 27&28 Shuffle forward with ½-turn L,R,L 29, 30 Rock R back, recover on L

31&32 Kick R forward, step R next to L, step L in place

*alternate for step 20: kick L back
